Canadian Tire Jumpstart Guidelines

There is a growing need in our communities to make physical activity a priority in the lives of Canadian children. Canadian Tire is committed to providing Canadian children with the opportunity to participate in sports and recreation so they can develop essential life skills, self-esteem and confidence. To help make this happen, the Canadian Tire Foundation for Families has introduced a national signature program, Canadian Tire JumpStart, which delivers assistance to give all kids a sporting chance.

Canadian Tire JumpStart Program Purpose:

“The Canadian Tire JumpStart is a charitable program created by the Canadian Tire Foundation for Families to help kids in financial need participate in organized sport and recreation.”

Guidelines for Funding:

- Ages: 5 to 18
- Funding up to \$300 per child per application period
- More than one child/youth in the same family may receive funding in the same season.
- Funding preference is to pay for registration fees, with consideration to fund equipment
- Funding should be for a sustained program that lasts a season
- The program is designed to get children active. Any sport or recreation should include physical activity
- As funding is limited and applications often exceed the annual allotment for the Chapter, applicants may receive less than the \$300.00 maximum
- Cheques for registration fees will be written to the organization, payment for equipment will be sent to the store specified
