### WHO CAN VOTE?

To be able to vote, you must meet the following requirements:

- Canadian citizen on October 8, 2020;
- 18 years of age on October 8, 2020;
- Resident of Nova Scotia before April 8, 2020; and
- Resident of Queens County before October 8, 2020, and are entitled to be registered on the list of electors and to vote.

### WHERE DO I VOTE?

If you meet the eligibility criteria above to vote, then you vote at the appropriate polling station noted in this newsletter. Regardless of where your name may be on a List of Electors, on Election Day, you vote at the voting place assigned to your civic address (see chart on page 2-3).

If your name is not on the final List of Electors, you can still vote. Go to your polling station on one of the voting days, and complete a form to be added to the List of Electors.

**Remember: ON Election Day,  
you vote at the polling station assigned to  
your civic address.**

### WHEN ARE THE ADVANCE POLLS?

An elector may vote at one of the Advance Polls if they expect to be unable to vote on ordinary polling day (Saturday, October 17, 2020). All Advance Polls are open 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m. **All Districts in Region of Queens Municipality may vote at any Advance Poll.**

### VOTING BY PROXY

**Any elector can vote by proxy if:**

- they plan to be away from Queens on both Advance Polling days and Regular Polling day, OR
- they are unable to attend at their polling station because of illness, physical disability or Covid-19, AND
- their name is on the final list of electors or they have a Certificate of Eligibility.

The last day to have proxy papers filled out and returned to the Municipal Office is Friday, October 9, 2020. Proxy voters can only vote on Ordinary Polling Day; they cannot vote at Advance Polls.

A person can only be a proxy voter for one non-relative, but can be a proxy voter for any number of relatives that include a child, grandchild, brother, sister, parent, grandparent, husband or wife of the proxy voter, as long as they live within Queens County.

Voting in Region of Queens Municipality's 2020 Municipal election will be by paper ballot only. Options for casting your vote are to vote on Election Day at the polling station in your district (October 17, 2020), vote at any Advance Poll on October 8 or October 13, or cast a vote by Proxy on October 17. ## CERTIFICATE OF ELIGIBILITY

A person who is not on the final List of Electors may apply for a certificate of eligibility to vote up until 5:00 p.m. on October 5, 2020. Once a certificate of eligibility is issued, a person's name is deemed to appear on the final List of Electors.

This certificate of eligibility is useful in two ways. If a person wishes to vote by proxy and their name is not on the final List of Electors, then they can apply for a certificate of eligibility in order to be eligible to vote by proxy. The second advantage for a person not on the list to obtain a certificate of eligibility is the reduced time that it will take to vote. With a certificate of eligibility, there is no requirement to be sworn in at the poll when you vote.
