



WE ARE DOG FRIENDLY IN QUEENS!

With plenty of scooping bag dispensers, wide open parks and miles of trails, dogs and their owners are found all over the County. We only ask that your pooches be registered and that the Dog Bylaw be respected.

Report a dog at large/stray dog, dangerous dog, or lost dog to Bylaw Enforcement at 902-354-3455.

Dogs impounded at the Municipal Dog Pound are kept comfortable while we try to reunite them with their owner. An impound fee of \$25 is due, which covers capture, preparation of notices, and care of dog, and \$5 per day board charge for each 24 hour period or portion thereof.

Dogs make great companions however; pet ownership comes with responsibilities.

A few things to remember:

- Registering your dog will help in reuniting you quickly if it strays
- Pick up and properly dispose of your dog's feces promptly
- A dog that persistently disturbs the quiet of a neighbourhood by barking, howling or otherwise may be impounded with or without notice to the owner
- If a dog is re-homed within Queens, relocated outside of Queens, passes away, owners change address, or a new dog is added to a household, the owner must advise Bylaw Enforcement
- Dogs leaving the premises of their owner must be under effective restraint or control. If off premises and not restrained or under effective control, a dog is classed as running at large
- Dogs who are considered to be fierce or dangerous may be impounded or destroyed



DOG REGISTRATION

Registration of dogs is required each year, and is in effect for the fiscal year, from April 1 to March 31. A record of each registered dog is kept by the Municipality, and upon payment of the annual fee a metal tag is issued which must be on the dog's collar at all times. Dog registration is required within 30 days of the dog reaching 6 months of age, or within 30 days of bringing it into the municipality, or by the registration deadline of April 30 in all other cases.

Fees for Altered dogs (ie; spayed or neutered) **are \$10 per year and Unaltered dogs are \$30 per year.**

Payment can be made in person at 249 White Point Road, Liverpool during business hours or can be mailed to the address on the form. **** A dog trained to assist a person with a disability is exempt from the fee, but is still required to be registered.**

PENALTIES

Owners failing to abide by the Dog Bylaw are subject (upon conviction) to a fine of no less than \$100 up to a maximum of \$1000.
