TAKE NOTICE that nomination papers are now available at the Region of Queens Municipality Administration Office, 249 White Point Road, Liverpool for the following offices in the Region of Queens Municipality for which an election will be held on October 17, 2020:

MAYOR for the Region of Queens Municipality

ONE COUNCILLOR for each of Polling Districts 1 through 7

AND TAKE NOTICE that a nomination for Mayor or Councillor shall be filed at the office of the Returning Officer, Region of Queens Municipality Administration Office, 249 White Point Road, Liverpool between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on nomination day which is Tuesday, September 8, 2020, **OR by appointment** during office hours in the 7 business days preceding nomination day;

AND TAKE NOTICE that electors in the Region of Queens Municipality, District of Chester, District of Lunenburg, Town of Mahone Bay, Town of Lunenburg and the Town of Bridgewater will elect one person to be a Member of the Conseil scolaire acadien provincial. Nomination papers for that office shall be filed with Amanda Shupe at her office located at Bridgewater Town Hall, 60 Pleasant Street, Bridgewater between 9:00 am. and 5:00 pm. on nomination day which is Tuesday, September 8, 2020, OR by appointment beginning in the 7 business days preceding Nomination Day between the hours of 8:30 am. – 4:30 pm. Appointments can be arranged by calling (909) 541-4389. Nomination papers are available for pick up at her office located at Bridgewater Town Hall, 60 Pleasant Street, Bridgewater, between 9:00 am. – 3:00 pm. Monday to Friday, except holidays.

AND TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that any person wishing to be entitled to be nominated for Mayor or Council in this election must meet the following requirements:

- a. is a Canadian citizen of the full age of eighteen years at the time of nomination;
- b. has been ordinarily resident in the municipality or in an area annexed to the municipality on March 7, 2020 and continues to so reside;
- c. has obtained a certificate from the Region that as of nomination day, the rates and taxes and other charges of all kinds due to the municipality have been fully paid; and
- d. is not disqualified under the Municipal Elections Act.
