2018 - 2019 INVESTMENT IN COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

NO COST	Development of a public engagement strategy to ensure consultation, communication, and collaboration with residents and businesses is clearly structured and established.
\$ 750	Facilitate a meeting with local health care practitioners to better understand the current health care environment, what initiatives or leadership is required of the Municipality, and what is required to ensure everyone in Queens has access to a primary health care provider.
\$100,000	Review of our Region-wide Municipal Planning Strategy and Land Use Bylaw, with a focus of community discussions to ensure long term sustainability of our coastal lands and protecting the quiet residential aspects of our neighbourhoods.
\$ 2,500	Develop a schedule of activities and events to highlight the Municipality during Municipal Awareness Week in November, including hosting open houses and giving tours at our major facilities.
NO COST	Establishment of a community engagement progress and procedure for us to follow for all major capital infrastructure investment projects.
\$ 2,500	Host a budget open house in January to allow residents to better understand and talk with as many government agencies and community groups that receive, or apply for, municipal funding.
