

Summerville Beach Provincial Park

This beach has a one kilometer stretch of soft white sand, and it's backed by sand dunes (a nesting area for Piping Plovers). At the far end of the road, there's a spot to enjoy a picnic off the beach. There are covered picnic tables, which are still close enough to the beach to hear the surf.

There are washrooms and change huts available at the picnic park.

The site is about 10 minutes west of Liverpool. It's also about 8 minutes from Nova Scotia Highway 103.
