- Region of Queens Municipality is responsible for winter maintenance of:
 - Municipal Administration Building
 - Liverpool Business Development Centre
 - Waterfront Parking (along Henry Hensey Drive)
 - Main Street Downtown Parking



What is winter maintenance?

Winter maintenance includes snow removal, anti-icing, and de-icing work that is carried out by Region of Queens Municipality Department of Infrastructure staff before, during, and after a winter storm. By policy of Council, crews prioritize providing safe routes for emergency vehicles and first responders, balanced with cleaning arterial, collector, and local streets and sidewalks. Staying informed about winter service levels helps everyone stay prepared, safe, and realistic about travel during the winter season.

How can you help?

Whether it's work or an appointment, sometimes you have to be out in bad weather. Parking your vehicle in serviced Priority Parking Areas allows our winter maintenance crews more room to operate safely and efficiently. See the table below for service level and timeline details in key Priority Parking Areas.*

Municipal Administration Building 249 White Point Road	Parking lot on south side of White Point Rd. and front walkways will be serviced. Surfaces may be snow covered.	All asphalt parking lots are serviced, with some bare asphalt showing. Gravel parking lot is snow-packed. All entrances and sidewalks cleared with some bare surfacing.
Liverpool Business Development Centre 54 Harley Umphrey Dr.	Priority parking sections are to be plowed, and entrances and exits to be maintained. Surfaces will be snow covered.	Entire parking lot is serviced, with some bare asphalt showing. All entrances and sidewalks cleared with some bare surfacing.
Main St. Parking, Waterfront Parking & Astor Theatre/ Town Hall Arts & Cultural Centre Parking	Priority parking sections to be plowed. Surfaces will be snowcovered.	The entire parking lot is serviced, with some bare asphalt showing.
Pine Grove Park 44 Highway 8, Milton	Surfaces snow-packed.	Parking area at Milton Rd plowed. Gravel surfaces will be snow-packed.
