

Traffic stats and stats coded to Traffic Units have been removed.







- Queens District RCMP members conducted eleven check stops at various locations throughout Queens County during this quarter.
- Queens District RCMP members issued eighty-one summary offence tickets and fifty-seven written warnings during this quarter.
- Queens District RCMP has implemented a strategic check point program to be conducted in high visibility areas throughout the municipality.

## 8. COMMUNITY POLICING OFFICER

Cst. Andrew Winsor has remained very active within the Region of Queens Municipality as well as the Schools throughout this reporting period. Cst. Winsor also continues to take on the additional role of general duty policing during HR shortages and short term sick leave. With the staffing levels coming to a balance, we look to utilize the CPO for additional Community Relation activities.

- Cst. WINSOR has been taking on General Duties throughout this past year in order to alleviate call volumes from the watches during staffing shortages.
- Cst. WINSOR continues to maintain a positive presence within Queens County schools and is responsible for dealing with the majority, if not all of occurrences that originate within the schools as well as regularly participating in "Lock-Down" drills, including two this quarter.
- Cst. Winsor conducted a presentation at the Queens Manor and discussed the topic of patient abuse.
- This past quarter, Cst. WINSOR obtained the Sexual Assault Investigators Workshop in Headquarters. This workshop was five day training specializing in investigations and interviews as it related to sexual assaults.
- Cst. Winsor attended the Senior Expo at the Best Western with our Senior Safety Coordinator.

## 9. SIGNIFICANT / NOTEWORTHY

Some significant and noteworthy items this past quarter include the following:

- There were no Motor Vehicle Fatality Investigations this quarter.
- Members responded to thirty-seven motor vehicle collisions during this quarter. Six individuals were injured as a result of these collisions and the remaining were property damage.
- Two individuals who were arrested on B&E charges while in the act, then a subsequent search of the vehicle lead to the seizure of over 6 ounces of cocaine (187 grams), 4 grams of crack cocaine, numerous drug paraphernalia, weapons (bear mace and a large dagger) and over \$1400 on cash. There was an abundance of evidence of drug trafficking and the vehicle (a white 2012 Audi S4) was impounded and seized, turned over to the RCMP Proceeds of Crime Unit.
- There were nine reported break & enters during this quarter. One of which have resulted in charges being laid. Four were unfounded and four resulted in insufficient evidence to proceed.
- There were eight shoplifting complaints this quarter.
- Six Sexual offences were reported during this quarter. One of those incidents resulted in charges and another investigation remains ongoing.
- Twenty-six Assault investigations conducted this quarter, seven of which resulted in charges.
- Members conducted seven human death investigations during this quarter, all non-suspicious.
- There were three Missing Person investigations, all in which the subjects were located.
- Members responded to fifty calls for service related to individuals experiencing mental health crisis.
- Police have conducted seventy-eight curfew checks this quarter on Court Ordered Offenders in a Crime Reduction Strategy.
- Police dealt with fourteen incidents of possible impaired driving during this quarter. Charges were laid in three instances.
