- Region of Queens Municipality is responsible for winter maintenance of the surfaces at Queens Place Emera Centre, including sidewalks, entrances, and parking spaces. See below to learn more about Priority Parking Areas and how you can help our snow-clearing crews work more efficiently.



What is winter maintenance?

Winter maintenance includes snow removal, anti-icing, and de-icing work that is carried out by Region of Queens Municipality Department of Infrastructure staff before, during, and after a winter storm. By policy of Council, crews prioritize providing safe routes for emergency vehicles and first responders, balanced with cleaning arterial, collector, local streets and sidewalks, and municipally managed parking areas.

Ensuring that you park in the designated Priority Parking Areas at Queens Place Emera Centre gives our winter maintenance crews more room to operate safely and efficiently when clearing after a storm.

What to expect at Queens Place during and after a storm

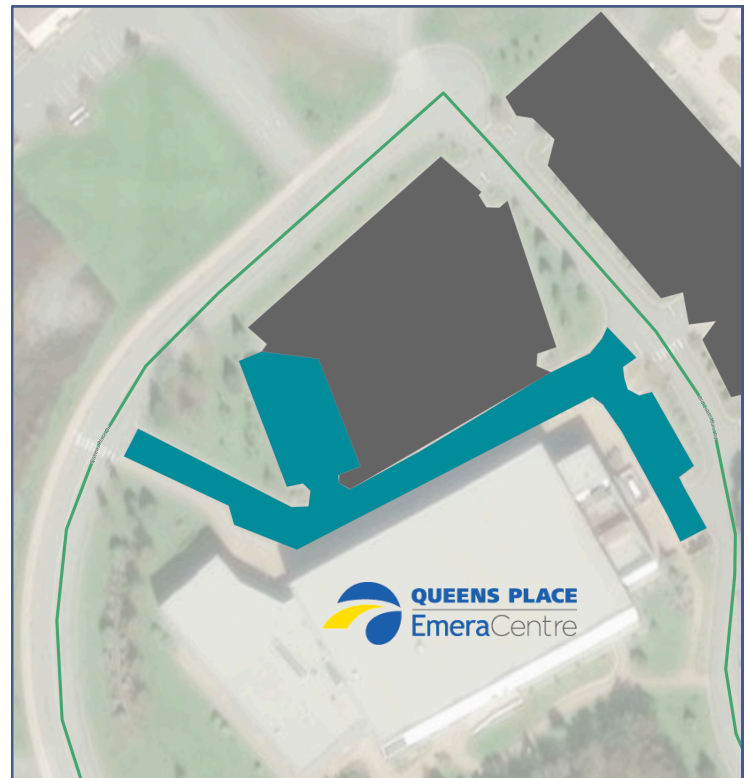
DURING THE STORM

Priority Parking Areas and the driving area near Queens Place (marked in blue on the map to the right) to be plowed, and entrances and exits to be maintained so the public can use the facility. Surfaces will be snow-covered.

AFTER THE STORM ENDS

6 HOURS - Priority Parking Areas are serviced, with some bare asphalt showing. All entrances and sidewalks cleared with some bare surfacing.

12 HOURS - Entire parking lot is serviced, with some bare asphalt showing. All entrances and sidewalks cleared with some bare surfacing.
