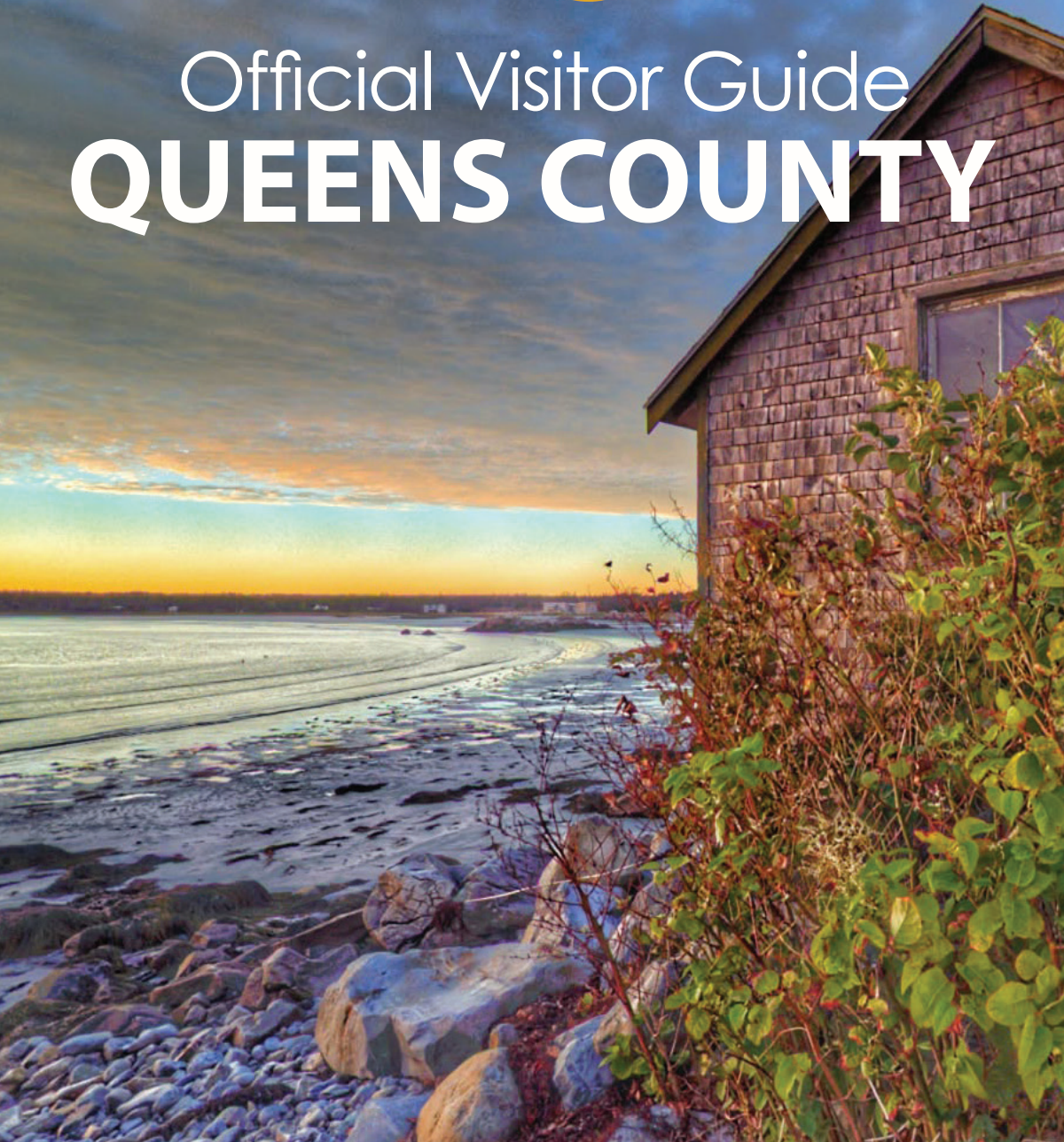

OFF-ROAD ADVENTURES QUEENS COUNTY ATV ASSOCIATION

Created in the 1980s with the goal of creating and managing recreational OHV trails. They established a combination of Municipal and Provincial Road Trails that provide 100% legal connectivity through South Queens, connecting Lunenburg and Shelburne County. Their trail network includes access to fuel, restaurants, shopping, and accommodations, making Liverpool a destination riding area. In North Queens, there is a large riding district that connects to four counties with access to a variety of services and points of interest starting from Caledonia. KEJIMKUJIK NATIONAL PARK & NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE

Discover a **CULTURAL LANDSCAPE** within the **UNESCO** Southwest Nova Biosphere Reserve

With 381 km² of rolling hills and interconnected waterways, Kejimikujik is a gentle wilderness where generations of families have canoed, camped and connected with nature for years. Its diverse woodlands and wetlands are bursting with wildlife creating a unique biodiversity hotspot like no other. Kejimikujik is home to 178 species of birds as well as mammals, and the greatest diversity of reptiles and amphibians in Atlantic Canada.



Not only does Kejimikujik protect a representation of the Acadian forest, it also preserves and presents a unique Mi'kmaw cultural landscape, honouring the presence of the Mi'kmaq since time immemorial and providing opportunities for the Mi'kmaq to share their stories and traditions today.

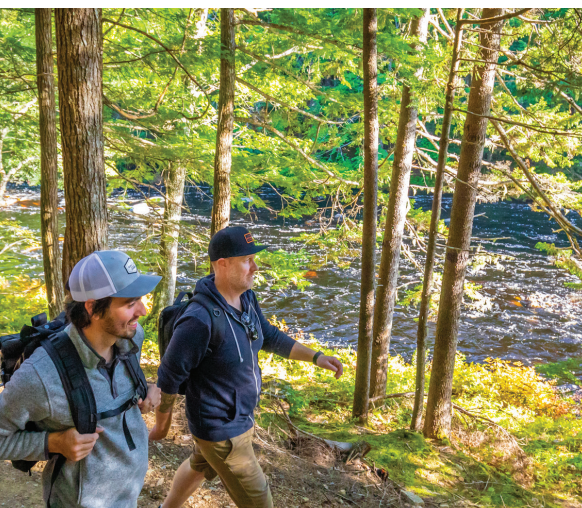
The Mi'kmaw culture is deeply-rooted in Kejimikujik, visitors can connect with the stories of this land and its people through activities such as the popular Petroglyph Paddle. Demonstrations at the the Etli-Mawita'mk : The Gathering Place, located on the shoreline of beautiful Kejimikujik Lake, showcase traditional skills like flint knapping and Mi'kmaw quillwork. The opportunity to witness and learn about the living history and the contemporary experience of the Mi'kmaq is one of a kind!

A Kejimkujik shared-use trail, Ukme'k (pronounced "ook-may-k"), meaning "twisted" in Mi'kmaq, is 6.3 km long and connects the campground with popular day-use areas. Ukme'k gives visitors an opportunity to interact with the Mi'kmaw cultural landscape as it twists along the historic and culturally significant Mersey River. Mountain bikers will enjoy the intermediate-level challenges like rollers, berms, and rock crossings that beginners can easily bypass. Ukme'k offers excitement and beauty in one!

Built in 1980, the Queens County Museum was designed to look like a large warehouse from Liverpool's Colonial days. Queens County is steeped in history, beginning with the Mi'kmaq people. The French influence began in 1604, followed by the New England Planters in 1759. Over the years, the people of Queens County have chronicled the area's rich history and its inherent link to the sea and forest. Queens County Museum houses many of these stories. Get your inner Privateer on when you step aboard the scale deck replica of the famous Privateer ship, the "Liverpool Packet". The museum also features exhibits on early medicine, our marine history, wartime memorabilia, and other stories from along the shore. The Museum gift shop offers a variety of items - giftware, souvenirs, local art, jewelry, and much more. Admission by donation.

THOMAS H. RADDALL RESEARCH CENTRE

The Thomas H. Raddall Research Centre, located inside the Queens County Museum, is a haven for the genealogist or anyone looking to deep dive into their roots. It is a treasured part of the museum with its early Township records from 1759, including details on many Mayflower families who eventually settled here. Fort Point Lighthouse is a valuable and rare surviving example of pre-Confederation lighthouses. It played an important role in the history of Liverpool, and both the lighthouse and the site are integral to the historical character of the town. Built in 1855, it is the third oldest surviving lighthouse in Nova Scotia and it is open seasonally. Since the 18th century, Fort Point hosted a signal station and, during the American Revolution, an earthwork defence and palisade was erected and armed with cannons to protect the harbour from privateers. The park surrounding this Provincial Heritage Property is open year-round offering picnic tables, interpretive panels, and a beautiful view of Liverpool harbour and Coffin Island lighthouse. Free admission.
