The Heritage Advisory Committee met in December to review the file and all agreed with this designation.

Mary Darr, Port Mouton – Ms. Darr stated there were many reasons for the designation of the Spectacle Lighthouse, which it presently has Federal Heritage status. \$11,000 was spent on repairs last year.

Mary Edgar, Carters Beach Road, Port Mouton – Ms. Edgar thanked the Region to their assistance.

Lucy Burgess, Port Joli – Ms. Burgess stated a permit to build a dock was received and the Society will be putting in a floating dock in the spring which will make it more accessible. A plaque for the Federal Heritage designation will be mounted this summer.

**4.0 CLOSING REMARKS:**


Mayor Dagley thanked the members of the Spectacle Light Society for attending and stated Councillors will discuss during the Regular Council meeting.
