


BYLAW NO. 25

A BYLAW TO REPEAL A BYLAW RESPECTING THE FIRING OF GUNS

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Region of Queens Municipality, under authority of the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter 18 of the Statutes of Nova Scotia 1998, as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 5, A Bylaw Respecting the Firing of Guns adopted by the Council of Town of Liverpool on the 17th day of December 1897 and approved thereafter by the Governor in Council on the 19th day of January 1898, is hereby repealed.
