

BYLAW NO. 5

A BYLAW RESPECTING THE FIRING OF GUNS

1. This bylaw shall be known as Bylaw Number 5 and may be cited as "The Firing of Guns Bylaw".

REGULATIONS

2. No person shall discharge in the Town any fire-arm, except in the discharge of some military duty or exercise required by law, or set off any fire-cracker, squib, or other fireworks, or set any fire in the streets of the Town, except with the permission of the Mayor and under such regulations as he may prescribe from time to time.
3. No person shall burn combustible material of any kind or description in or upon any of the sidewalks, streets, highways, squares, or thoroughfares of the Town, under a penalty not exceeding five dollars for each offense.
